

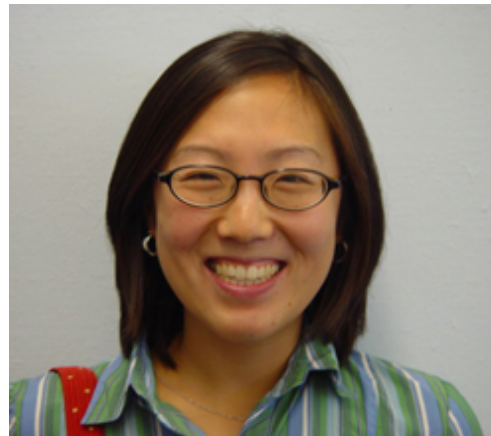
## ITS Grad Students Collect Eisenhower and Eno Awards for 2007

Once again, all four ITS affiliates were well-represented among the 2007 award winners for the two leading national prize competitions for transportation graduate students. Five students at three campuses won [Dwight David Eisenhower Graduate Fellowships](#). Five students (out of a total of 20 nationwide) from three campuses were awarded [Eno Fellowships](#).

- the **Eisenhower awards** enable students to pursue advanced degrees in transportation-related fields at universities of their choice and are awarded to students for up to three years; they also subsidize students' attendance at the annual TRB conference in Washington, D.C.
- the **Eno Awards** bring students to the Eno Leadership Conference, held annually in Washington, D.C., to provide "exceptionally promising master's and doctoral degree students who plan to pursue careers in transportation with a first-hand look at how transportation policy is developed and implemented," said Tom Downs, Eno Transportation Foundation President and CEO.

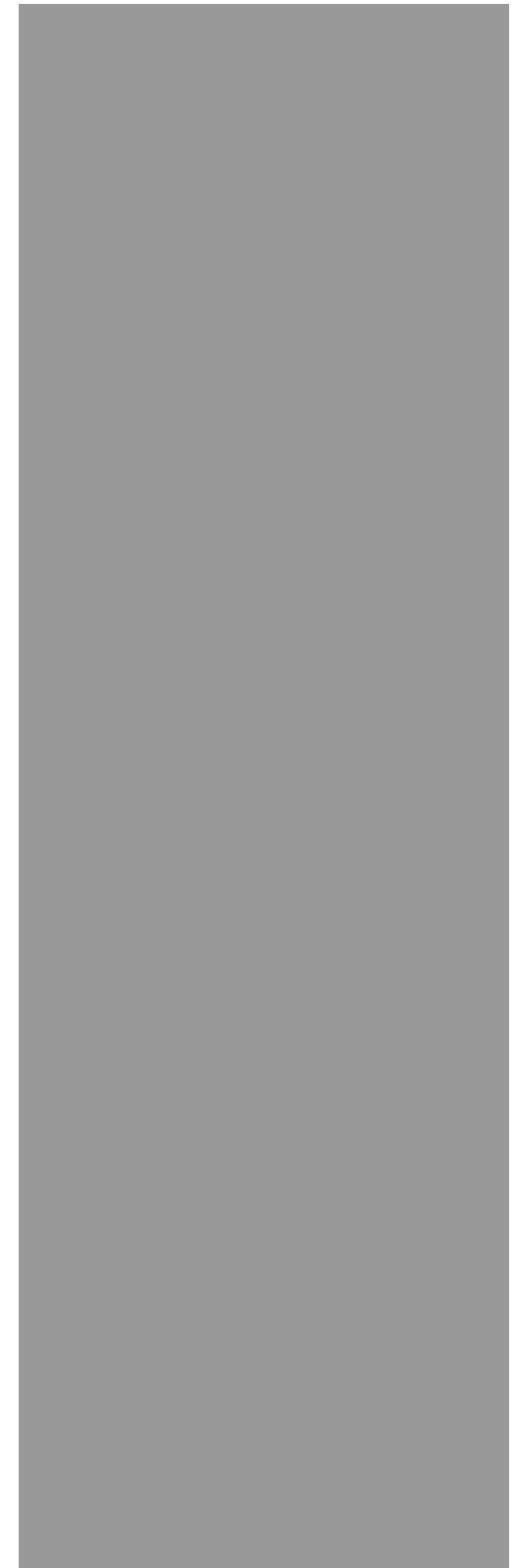

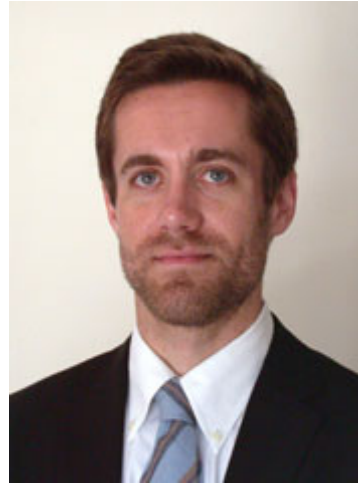
